BEFORE YOU LEAVE HOME – HEALTH CHECK

Does your child have any of these symptoms?

- \Rightarrow Fever
- \Rightarrow Chills
- \Rightarrow Cough
- \Rightarrow Sore throat
- \Rightarrow Stuffy or runny nose
- \Rightarrow Headache
- \Rightarrow Fatigue
- \Rightarrow Muscle aches
- \Rightarrow Loss of appetite
- \Rightarrow Shortness of Breath



If yes, for any of these symptoms, your child must stay home. If your child comes to school with any of these symptoms, we will have to put your child in one of our medical rooms and call a parent to come get the child immediately.



DRESS FOR THE WEATHER

WE ARE GOING OUTSIDE LOTS! We have been asked to take the students outside frequently. We will do this even with if it is raining slightly. Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately to go outside each day.

WHAT TO PACK IN YOUR CHILD'S BACK PACK

- * Full water bottle
- * Easy to eat snack no need to ask for help to open it
- Lunch with easy to eat foods and containers your child can open alone all food items and wrappers to be taken home – no composting at school
- * No sunscreen (apply at home before coming to school)
- Hat/cap
- * Umbrella
- * Raincoat and/or sweater (we will be outside lots)
- * No inside shoes please (UPDATE)
- Pencil box or case with 2 pencils, eraser, pencil sharpener, scissors, glue stick, coloured pencils or wax crayons (depending on the grade), markers, headphones if they have them, small toy that does not make noise, preferably no open toed shoes
- * Device, if they want to bring it to do school work and/or bring school loaned device each day

Please remember all items as we want to avoid parents dropping by the school to drop items off. **Parents are currently not allowed in the school building.**



STAGGERED DROP OFF & PICK UP TIMES:

 \Rightarrow 8:30 am Drop Off AND 2:30 Pick up for Last Names A – K

⇒ 8:45 am Drop Off AND 2:45 Pickup for Last Names L – Z

We need to have these staggered times to minimize the amount of people lining up together and to allow for easy drop off and pick up of students, as parents are asked to remain in their cars or at the perimeter of the school yard.

WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU DROP OFF YOUR CHILD AT SCHOOL?

During this time, ideally, we would like all students dropped off and picked up at the front of the school. This will make it easier for us to manage social distancing. When you drop off at school – please remain in your car or if walking drop-off at the perimeter of the school yard, crosswalk or back pathway – we will have staff there to walk your children to their line ups.

At this time we expect all students to go directly to their new designated line ups. They are not to congregate or play on the playground before and after school.

WHAT WILL A TYPICAL SCHOOL DAY LOOK LIKE DURING JUNE 2020?

PARENTS PLEASE KEEP IN MIND THAT DURING THIS FIRST WEEK WITH UP TO 50% ATTENDANCE OUR TEACHERS WILL BE ADJUSTING TO SUPPORTING STUDENTS IN CLASS AND ONLINE. REGULARLY SCHEDULED GROUP AND INDIVIDUAL TEAM MEETINGS WILL MOST LIKELY NOT HAPPEN AS WAS PREVIOUSLY DONE. NEW WAYS OF MEETING AND WORKING WILL EVOLVE AS EACH WEEK PROGRESSES.

- \Rightarrow Students will be handwashing as soon as they arrive in their classrooms
- ⇒ We will have what we call a soft start (students will do a quiet activity at their desk or table until all students arrive)
- \Rightarrow Students will engage in learning
- \Rightarrow Students will have a bathroom break, wash their hands and eat their snack (supervised by a teacher)
- \Rightarrow Students will go outside for about 15 minutes
- \Rightarrow Students will wash their hands
- \Rightarrow Students will engage in learning
- \Rightarrow Students will have a bathroom break, wash their hands and eat their lunch (supervised by a teacher)
- \Rightarrow Students will go outside for about 30-45 minutes
- \Rightarrow Students will wash their hands
- \Rightarrow Students will do a quiet activity at their desk or table
- \Rightarrow Students will engage in learning
- \Rightarrow Students will have a bathroom break, wash their hands and go outside for about 15 minutes
- \Rightarrow Students will clean up for the day and pack all of their belongings
