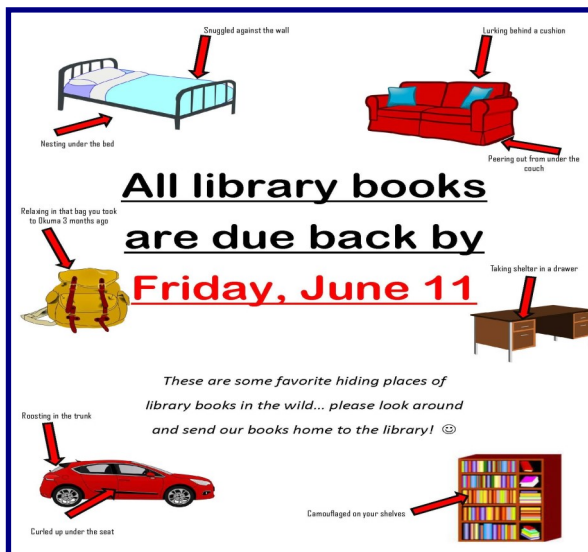
GRADE 7 Farewell Celebration

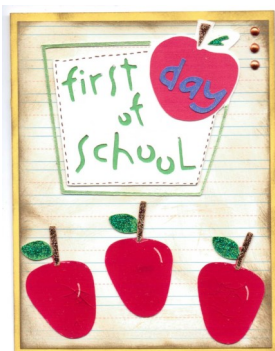
MOVING

School Fees Information for 2021-2022

Each school year, parents support their child(ren)'s formal learning experiences in a wide variety of ways. We appreciate all that you do to ensure a successful year.

In addition to providing the school supplies itemized on a grade list, parents are periodically asked for monies to cover specific items and/or special events. As we plan for the upcoming school year, we anticipate the following costs:

Student Planner: We encourage all students in Grades 1-7 to purchase a School Planner at a cost of \$5.00. Included in the planner is our school code of conduct, school calendar and school district information. We find this to be an excellent tool for facilitating home/school communication, as well as for developing our students' organizational skills. However, using our school planner is optional.

Field Studies and Field Trips: Classes often enjoy educational visits to community facilities which extend and enhance the curriculum. While we use school monies or fundraise to cover the costs of such activities wherever possible, there are times when parents are asked to contribute towards the cost of the trip. If you choose to have your child not participate in a field study, a suitable program will be provided at the school.

Musical Instruments: Grade 4 students may learn to play the recorder. Students will have the option of purchasing one through the school or receiving one on loan from the school. The cost of the recorders will be known at the beginning of the school year. Also, our Grade 7 students who choose to take band either purchase or rent an instrument. Costs vary depending on the instrument.

School Supplies: For students in Grades 1-3, parents have the option of purchasing their child's school supplies on their own utilizing the grade supply list or for your convenience you may wish to purchase supplies from Edupac. Payment of these supplies from Edupac will be made to your child's teacher in September. Cost for supplies will be \$40.

Kindergarten: parents have the option of purchasing their child's school supplies on their own utilizing the grade supply list posted on our website or purchasing through the school a one-time fee of \$40.00 for supplies. This cost will cover supplies.

Be assured we will be sensitive to your needs and no student at Beaver Creek will be denied an opportunity to participate in any activity or receive the necessary school item through an inability to pay. Please let your child(ren)'s teacher or Ms. Anderson know if any of these fees present a financial hardship. Should you have any questions / and or concerns about school fees, please contact Ms. Anderson or Mr. MacLennan.

School supply fees for 2021-2022 may change due to circumstances in schools as a result of COVID-19.
