Every Child Matters



This past Friday, Tk'emlúps te Secwé pemc First Nation in Kamloops, B.C. announced the discovery of the remains of more than 215 children buried at the site of what was once a residential school. This news was a heartbreaking reminder of the trauma of residential schools, and the impacts that remain in our province today.

To honour these children and all those who suffered trauma and harm at the former residential school in Kamloops, all flags in our district will be flown at half-mast until further notice.

This horrific tragedy serves as a difficult reminder for survivors of residential schools and their families, of the hurt and intergenerational trauma they have endured. We will continue to care for our staff, students, and families in need of our support or resources, and we encourage anyone who needs additional support to reach out to their school. We must all continue to take care of each other.

Beginning tomorrow, June 1st and for 9 days, we are asking you to consider wearing, or displaying Orange as one way to honour and remember these children and their families; as well as showing support for Indigenous Peoples across Canada who will be feeling the impact of this discovery.

School Fees 2021/2022

The school district requires that we inform parents of the school fees for the upcoming school year. At Holly, our generous and hard-working parent group (Holly Society) supports students in various events and field studies to support their learning. In addition, they pay for student planners which cost \$5 each. 
