## Agenda Adopted

### Approval of Minutes

- May 2026 minutes - approved

### New Business:

- PAC will look into bringing Much-A-Lunch program back for 2026-2027 school year
  - Aiming for September/October start
  - Lunches once a month
  - Site shuts down for maintenance (July 1 – August 31)
  - Payments can be made if using safari
- Motion placed: Motion to make Victor fundraising coordinator
  - 4 yays – Motion passed.

## Reports

### Chairperson:

- Sports Day concession was a success
  - For future, look into changing set up for concession (have dividers set up so students only have 2 lines to get treats)
  - \$900 profit (\$910 was purchased, \$150 of items were returned)
  - Some miscommunications about where to pick up freezies
    - Consider having runners at break stations who will come to PAC concession to get the freezies and run it back to the rest stations)
    - Have class lists and opened freezies ready for pick up
    - Grade 7s can get them at the end of the day
- Organize a fundraising calendar for 2026-2027 school year
- Upcoming fundraisers:
  - Thursday June 18 – Freezie sale after school (\$2/freezie)
  - Tues June 23 and Wed. June 24 - Concession sale (sell leftover treats from Sports Day)

### Principal:

- Thank you to all PAC members for contribution and support
- Pickleball estimate:
  - \$15/student for 245 students = \$3675 + tax
  - Possible January 4 start for 8 sessions
- Drum Club cost update:
  - Twelve 14" drums - \$190 Per drum = \$2280
  - \$24/bag
  - \$400 for song teachings
- Re-envisioning the school's bear logo (Indigenizing it)
  - A proposal has been put out to indigenous nations, they can then see if there's an artist that can pick up the job, if not, there's another contact we can connect with
  - Only looking into redesigning the logo at this point
- June 19th = year-end gathering
  - present and past PAC welcome to come and say hello and show gratitude
- PAC kitchen update - learning resources will be removed by September to clear off space
- Technology needs to be updated
  - 6 new iPads were purchased, earmark some funds from PAC funds to update technology
- Leaving ceremony for the grade 7s on Tuesday June 23rd
- Setting up PAC channel on school teams for easy communication and sharing information

### Treasurer:

- Gaming grant is submitted, should be received in October
- Looking into 2023 state funds
- Goal for next year:
  - Budget tied into calendar (events, fundraisers, etc.) so we can govern how much fundraising we can do and what our targets would be
  - Live document for teacher PAC allowance to input expenses as they incur
