- Proof of Canadian citizenship or permanent residency:
 - Birth Certificate, Canadian passport, Canadian citizenship Card or Permanent Residence Card Proof of secondary school completion
- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Proof of secondary school completion
 - If you have studied out of the province or the country & require your education credentials evaluated visit the BCIT website at www.bcit.ca/ices/ to learn more about the International Credential Evaluation (ICES) that they offer.
- English 12 with a final grade of C+ (67%) or
 - Communications 12 with a min grade of A (86%) or
 - a post-secondary English course with a minimum of C- (50%) from a recognized post-secondary institution where English is the primary language of instruction in the past 5 years or
 - An English assessment may be required. Call our office about accepted English testing
- 2 Reference letters from a professional (non-family, non-friend) – forms are provided
- Handwritten letter of introduction outlining interest and experience with children, youth or adults with disabilities.
- Successful interview with College representative
- Clean Criminal Records Search from RCMP/local police (current within one year)
- Standard First Aid with CPR Level C-AE
- Signed contract and \$80.00 non-refundable enrolment fee
