KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Children who turn five years old before January 1, 2018 are eligible to begin school in September 2017. Information regarding documents required for registration and/or Choice Programs are included in page 3 of this document.

MESSAGE FROM THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

Currently, student progress is reported in many different ways, including report cards, parent teacher meetings and regular student/parent/teacher check-ins. The Ministry of Education has updated the curriculum for kindergarten to grade 9. Parents will be provided an opportunity to share their thoughts on report cards and all types of progress reporting. Ministry staff will be hosting a community session in Surrey at the Panorama Ridge Secondary School at 13220 64 Avenue on January 18, 2017 - between 5pm and 8 p.m.

Parents are encouraged to drop-in to a casual open house between 5 and 7 p.m., then take part in a fun brainstorming workshop from 7 to 8 p.m. Enjoy some refreshments and good conversation, and help shape the future of student progress reports in B.C.

KEEPING GERMS AWAY!

Hand washing and some healthy tips prevent the spread of germs. Take a few minutes to review these steps with your children:

- When washing hands, wet your hands & apply soap.
- Rub hands together for 20 seconds or sing a short song or rhyme. Rinse your hands for 10 seconds.
- Keep fingers away from the mouth area.
- Cough and sneeze into the elbow.
- Stay home if sick, not returning to school until the fever is absent for at least 24 hours or until vomiting is absent for 48 hours.

PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS UPON REGISTRATION AT THE SCHOOL:

In-person registration is required at the neighbourhood school or school of choice (if space is available). The following documents are required at the school when registering:

1. Proof of birth date for the student (birth certificate or passport).
2. Proof of guardianship (as shown on child's birth certificate, or other appropriate legal documentation such as landed immigrant document or guardianship order).
3. Proof of Citizenship for both the parent and student (Canadian Birth Certificate, Citizenship Card, Passport, Landed Immigrant Document, Permanent Resident Card, Enhanced Driver's License or Enhanced Identification Card).
4. Proof of residence (e.g., ordinarily resident) of parent/guardian in BC:
 - a. BC driver's license, BC Services Card, BCID or BC Care Card of parent/legal guardian; or
 - b. A combination of other supporting documentation such as ownership/long-term lease of dwelling, vehicle registration, employment within community, Canadian income tax record, etc.
5. Proof of living address (purchase or rental agreement, utility bill, driver's license, etc.).*

* Sullivan Heights Secondary, Woodward Hill Elementary, Goldstone Park Elementary, Cambridge Elementary, Hyland Elementary and Sullivan Elementary are subject to additional proof of living address requirements. Three pieces of ID showing address, one of which must be government issued, must be presented in order to complete the registration process.

Documents which are helpful, but not required:

- Health Documents (Care card, immunization records, medical condition information)
