Dear parents and guardians,

Our students have been working on the following expected behaviours in our school. Please take a minute to go over this with your child. A few items that particularly affect families are the before and after school expectations.

We are asking students to say good bye to their caregivers outside the building and use their outside doors - not the front door - to enter and exit the school. We truly appreciate your cooperation with this. It has already cut down on the noise and chaos of our hallways and is working to make our school a safer and more productive place. If your child is late, they may still enter through the front door after the second bell.

Where?	Katzie students will.....
Recess and lunch Outside	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - keep hands and feet to self - stay on school grounds and in safe play areas - safe play with outside materials - play fair - stay outside for the entire recess/lunch - food is eaten before you go outside
Recess and lunch Inside	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - quiet activity - seated/moving safely - stay in own room - listen and respect lunch monitors and noon-hour supervisors - stay in chosen area (classroom, gym, library)
Hallways	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - walk - single file - right side - silent - hands by your side or at your back - looking where you're going
Stairs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - walk - single file - right side (unless with a teacher who leads you on the left) - use all steps - one hand only on the railing
Washrooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - do your business in the toilet or urinal and flush - respect privacy - keep your eyes out of other people's stalls - clean up after yourself and wash your hands - quiet - straight back to class - use the washroom nearest your classroom

Assemblies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - enter silently - sit attentively -> on bottom, legs crossed, eyes on the front - silent throughout - stay in your place - appropriate responses to performance
Students from Portables	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - use a fob - enter school silently
Before and After school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - stay outside until the bell rings - use outside sidewalks to reach your classroom entrance - use only appropriate door for your class to enter and exit the school - say goodbye/meet your parent/caregiver outside the school - front door is off limits unless late
General expectations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - stay out of photocopy, paper, and gym equipment rooms unless supervised by an adult - listen to all staff when they speak to you - follow directions - be safe, kind, and caring to others

Children who are not registered to attend Kindergarten in September 2017 and are three and four year olds are invited with their parent or caregiver to visit our school for this exciting early learning event.

Ready, Set, Learn is a program designed to provide children and families with an opportunity to participate in a series of play-based learning activities within the school setting. This early learning program is part of an initiative sponsored by the Ministry of Education.
