Student Absences

SafeArrival Attendance System - 3 Ways to Report Absences

SafeArrival will allow parents to report their child's absence quickly and conveniently in one of three ways:

1. Log into the website sd36.schoolconnects.com
Authenticate Portal account to report absences and update contact information.
2. If you've authenticated your account, parents can download the *SafeArrival* app (all one word) and log in to report absences
3. Parents can report absences to an automated interactive telephone system via a toll-free number **1-844-423-1073**.

Please do not call the school to report absences.

By reporting your child absent in advance using *SafeArrival*, you will NOT receive an automated call requesting information regarding your child's absence.

All absence and late arrival reporting must go through *SafeArrival* (web, app or telephone 1-844-423-1073).

Please do not contact or send notes to the school or classroom teacher to report an absence or late arrival.

First Aid @ Katzie

Below are the First Aid services and processes at Katzie Elementary:

1. Surrey Elementary Schools do not have on-site nurses or medical staff for students.
2. The First Aid attendants at school are certified to meet Work Safe requirements and are available for staff injuries or **major** student injuries.
3. All student injuries will fall into three categories:
 - a. Level 1 – minor cuts and bruises
 - b. Level 2 – moderate injuries (head injury, twisted ankle, impact/fall)
 - c. Level 3 – serious injuries (ambulance is called)
4. In the event of student injuries, the following plan will be followed:
 - a. Level Injury – the noon hour supervisors, teacher and/or secretarial staff will provide students with a Band-Aid and/or small ice pack.
 - b. Level 2 Injury – parents will be immediately notified and the parent will make the decision to either pick up the child or have him/her remain at school until the end of the day.
 - c. Level 3 Injury – Our School First Aid Attendants (Ms. Chalmers and Mr. Gerbrandt) will assist.

PAYMENT IS DUE IMMEDIATELY UPON ORDERING. Order all at once, or month to month.

Payment can be made securely online with a credit card, now directly through the MunchaLunch system. Please follow the prompts. Or, you may drop off cheque payments DIRECTLY TO THE ADMIN OFFICE, clearly marked with your ORDER NUMBER, CHILDS NAME and DIVISION. Payments must be received no later than 2pm cutoff day - NO EXCEPTIONS!

Here's how to register if you are new to MunchaLunch – it's easy!:

- ➔ After adding your children, click the green "Order Lunch!" button to order
- ➔ Pay immediately for your order by credit card (or have cheque ready to deliver to school next day)
- ➔ Next time, just click the "Login Here" button to access your account.

ORDERING & PAYMENT INFORMATION

You can pay for your orders by credit card (securely online through the MunchaLunch system) or by cheque

Cheques are to be made payable to: Katzie Elementary PAC

All cheque payments MUST be clearly labelled with: **student name, division AND, order confirmation number**

Ordering and payments are a **2 step process**.

Step 1: You will receive a confirmation email when you have placed your order.

Step 2: You will receive a second confirmation email when payment is processed.

If you receive reminder emails requesting payment for your order it is because your account is not paid. Please contact katziehotlunch@gmail.com immediately if you are having payment troubles. Outstanding accounts result in unpaid orders which are not recognised in the reporting system for the Vendors, therefore are automatically cancelled out.

PARENT VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED FOR EACH DIVISION FOR DELIVERY OF FOOD TO CLASS. Sign up sheets will be posted at each classroom, and an online link will be made available through the school website & PAC Facebook page shortly. Due to the size of our school, we cannot run this program without way more help. Thank you in advance.

Katzie HotLunch also provides a lunch to our families in need so they don't miss out. You can help by adding a \$1 donation to your hotlunch order. Donations are not compulsory. Donate a little or a lot. Any donations we do receive, is greatly appreciated and thank you.

If your child is ill/away on a hot lunch date, **YOU** must arrange pick up by yourself/friend/ neighbour/fellow classmate for lunch time (12 noon) – we suggest you contact your Teacher or Divison Volunteer when arrangement has been made. Due to the size of our school, we are just not able to keep up with the amount of requests. ALL lunches will be delivered to the classrooms. Failure to collect lunch will result in lunch being given to another student or thrown out. We do not have the facilities to keep lunches for next day.

The HotLunch committee do their best to provide a variety of food items throughout the year. We are unable to certify items from food vendors to be allergen free, but we do our best to list possible allergens, contents and/or ingredients. All menu's, if possible will have something that is dairy/nut free & vegetarian. Please feel free to review the menus in MunchaLunch and we encourage parents to contact the Vendor directly for futher ingredient information.

Orders can be cancelled up until the order close date for each individual Hot Lunch date. Any payment received will sit as a credit on your account for future use. Orders cannot be cancelled after cut off date as items have already been ordered from vendor.

Sorry, there are **NO REFUNDS** as this is a PAC fundraiser. We appreciate your support for our Hot Lunch Program as we build funds for our school for music equipment, sports equipment, electronics, field trips and much, much more.
