



LAM COVID-19 Safety Procedures 2021-2022 (August 31, 2021)

- Masks are mandatory while inside the building, exceptions for those with medical accommodations
- Hand hygiene expected whenever entering the building (sanitation stations provided)
- 2 meter distancing not required; however, respecting everyone's personal space and comfort level is appreciated and expected
- Floor signage has been removed; consistent movement and uncongested flow is expected in the hallways and stairwells and building entrances (reminder to stay to the right)
- Lockers are not to be gathering places, please proceed to outside areas or large open spaces
- Daily health checks remain in place. Staff – please respond to daily email; parents/guardians – please review the K-12 Health Check app. Reminder to stay home when experiencing illness symptoms
- School extracurricular and social gatherings permitted, adhering to provincial public health orders; participant and guest lists with accurate contact information to be maintained for 45 days. More information will follow as these events and activities gradually resume
- Carpooling by families, students, staff expected to be consistent “bubble groups”
- Food services permitted adhering to PHO and Food Safe practices. We will have cafeteria services; sharing food and beverages among individuals is not permitted
- School cleaning – minimum 1x day (more in high use areas)

NB#1 Vaccination rates for the 12-17 age group in Fraser Health is about 75% for one dose and just shy of 60% for two doses. This data is from mid-August so both rates will have increased somewhat (hopefully above 80% before school starts for one dose).

NB#2 LAM received summer upgrades to ventilation systems, classroom and office air controller systems, and a new air conditioner unit (completed August 25)
