September 7th Homeroom Information:

- Gr 9-12: Students report to their homeroom teacher at 10am (30 minutes approximately). Students must check their schedules on MYEDBC. Homeroom teacher is the Period 1 teacher.
- Gr 8: Students arrive at 12:00. Students will find the name of their homeroom teacher on lists posted in several locations along the main hallway and will meet their teacher in the large gym (Large signs and many staff helpers will ensure students know where they are going). We anticipate Gr 8's will be dismissed by their homeroom teacher between 1:15 and 1:30.

Lockers & Fees:

Student fees apply to all students and are paid online (see attached). Please contact the office if you have concerns with paying your child's fee.

Gr 9-12 students will be able to select their lockers online after fees have been paid (see attached). All Gr 8 students will be given access to their lockers between September 8-10 regardless of when fees are paid. Classroom teachers will personally assist their Gr 8 students access their lockers.

Student Fees

Student fees for the 2021-2022 school year can be viewed and paid through <u>SchoolCash Online</u>. Fees include a basic student fee and, in some cases, students may be assessed a course fee to cover the cost of consumable materials. Students may also choose to purchase optional 'enhancements' that support a course, ie workbooks or field trip fees. Optional Yearbook fees will be assessed to all students. Fees can be paid three ways: on-line, cash, or cheque. Please note that School Fees for 2021-2022 may change due to circumstances in schools as a result of Covid-19.

<u>Lockers</u>

Locker selection for the 2021-2022 school year will be done online for all grades. Access to the site to select a locker will be available starting on September 7th, provided that outstanding Student Fees have been paid. Please note that there will be a system delay between the fee payment and the locker selection availability. To access the online locker website, click <u>HERE</u>. Attendance:

Please let us know if your child is to stay home when ill by calling the front desk on the day of the absence. If your child is going to be late they can pick up a late slip at the front office if a *parent or legal guardian* has called to excuse their child's tardiness on the same day. Please keep your child home if they are not feeling well as per Provincial Health Orders and ensure to follow the Daily Health Check K-12.
