In-Class (i.e. Face to Face) Instruction Suspended Indefinitely However, your learning is NOT over! It will just look different.

On March 17, the BC government suspended all in-class kindergarten through Grade 12 face to face instruction indefinitely to help contain the spread of COVID-19.

Students are NOT to come to school on Monday, March 30.

Our priority is your health and our community's health. That is why you are not at school and cannot come to school. The more human contact we all have right now, the more COVID 19 will spread.

YOU WILL NOT COME TO SCHOOL UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. Matheson administration will be crafting a plan that allows you, as students, to enter the school to pick up your books and other belongings that follow the standards of the Provincial Health Office. Stay tuned for that.
