Accessing your MyEdBC Portal account:



In your web browser, search for MyEducationBC
or go to [MyEducation BC: Log On](https://www.myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do) <https://www.myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do>

IMPORTANT TIPS:

- Use a computer (not your phone) to login the first time. You may not be able to change your password on a mobile device. Once you have logged in and successfully changed your password then you can login on your phone.
- On your phone to view all areas of MyEdBC you need to select “**view full site**” otherwise you will have limited access on the mobile version.
- If at any time you need your account reset, please email guildfordpark@surreyschools.ca and in the subject line enter “myed password reset”, in the email provide your name, student number, and/or parent name. *(do not sent multiple emails, your account will be reset as quickly as possible)*

MyEducation BC Password Requirements



Review the password requirements below and think about your what your new password should be before you try logging in. (example passwords: Grad@2029, pA#&2025)

What is a Symbol? Use Shift key + a number (ie. Shift+3 = #, Shift +5 = %, Shift+2 = @)

Password Requirements

- Minimum length is 8
- At least one number
- At least one capital and lowercase letter
- At least one symbol that isn't a letter or number
- Can't contain 'password', login name, first name, middle name, last name, date of birth, personal id, or only sequential letters or numbers

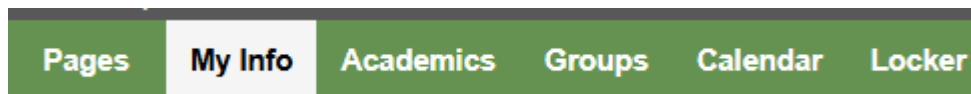

Re-setting Passwords / New MyED Accounts
