<b>Respect learning</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Attend all classes</li> <li>✓ Be on time - if you are late you need to check-in with the teacher before sitting down</li> <li>✓ Come to class prepared and ready to work</li> <li>✓ Be on task</li> <li>✓ Complete and hand in all homework/assignments</li> <li>✓ Study for tests</li> <li>✓ Bring supplies: course binders and textbooks, pencils, erasers, ruler, pens, calculator, agenda</li> <li>✓ Work to the best of your ability</li> <li>✓ Be involved and participate</li> <li>✓ Follow the directions of your teacher</li> <li>✓ Seek help</li> </ul> <p>We are usually available for help after school or set up an appointment</p>
