PAC has planned a night out for the 19+ crowd to raise funds toward the Grade 7 year end activities, including their camping trip!

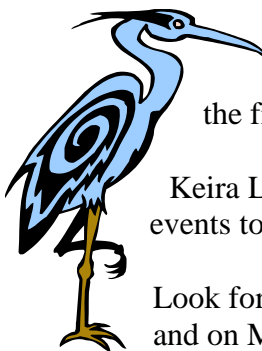
