In mid April we had 2 students from Sullivan Heights attend the Fire Service Youth Academy for 4 days at the Fire Training Centre by Hall 1. These 2 students were put through training exercises that simulate the job of being in the fire service. Both students had amazing experiences. Students also gain volunteer experiences with the Surrey Fire Service as part of the program. Applications for this program come out in December each year with the Academy scheduled for the spring. The Career Center would like to acknowledge the variety of companies that support our Work Experience Program. This semester our students are doing 2400 hours of work experience in the community. Students can sign up for WEX 12a with their counsellor. Next school year we will be looking to place our Business Ed Co-op students out for a 3 week placement.

## Naval Experience Program (NEP)

This 1 year paid program will provide exposure to life in the Royal Canadian Navy and help you decide if life in the Navy is the right fit for you. Following a streamlined enrollment, nine-week basic military training and four-week naval training, you will join the Naval fleet on either the East or West coast. Over the course of several months, you will learn the ropes of being a sailor by shadowing a variety of jobs and gaining exposure to several skills and opportunities. The program will include time at sea, giving you a sense of the adventures to be found in a naval career. Age 17 and older may apply.



## Pay, compensation and benefits

When participating in the Naval Experience Program, you will receive the same pay, compensation and benefits entitled to all members of the Canadian Armed Forces . If you decide to join and train in an area that requires university courses the Canadian Navy may help pay student tuition.

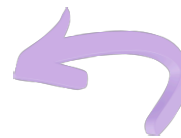

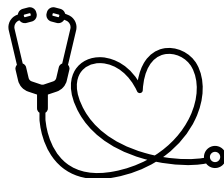

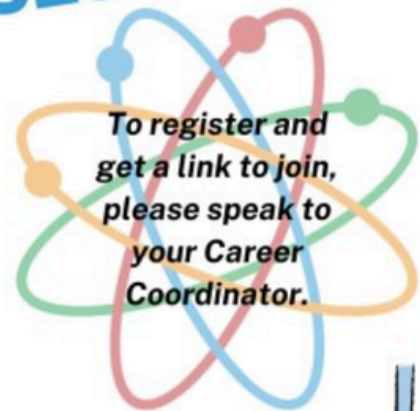
