Principal's Message

May 29th, 2020

We hope you and your family are doing well. We would like to extend our appreciation for the support and understand that members of our school community have shown as we transition to remote learning following Spring Break. Your efforts have helped us ensure that student learning has continued over the last two months. Thank you for completing the survey and indicating that you will be coming in for face-to-face tutorials for your class(es). We would like to go over the expectations for you to safely enter and exit the building along with other health and safety procedures.

Firstly, your health and the health of our staff is our primary concern.

Parents are required to assess their child(rens) health prior to arriving at school, so if you are experiencing cold, flu or COVID-19-like symptoms, even mild ones please do not come to school. Symptoms include: fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat and painful swallowing, stuffy or runny nose, loss of sense of smell, headache, muscle aches, fatigue or loss of appetite. Please contact 811 or seek medical attention.

If you begin to feel sick at school, you must inform your teacher so we can immediately contact parents for your pick up from the school site.

Entrance/Exits

- We have 2 entrances for students to enter and exit the building. You will exit the same door you entered.
- For students in grades 8 and 9 you will enter/exit at the doors located on the ground floor between the Purple/Yellow POD (This is located near 184th street on the west side of the building).
- For students in grades 10 you will enter/exit at the door located on the ground floor outside the Blue POD. (This is located along the driveway)
- For students in grades 11/12 you will enter/exit at either the Blue POD door or the Purple/Yellow POD stairs, depending on which teacher you are meeting.
- The front doors are reserved for staff only.
- Parents that would like to communicate with a teacher are asked to email the teacher directly. Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate any meetings with teachers at the school site at this time.

Arriving to school:

- You are asked to socially distance yourself when you arrive at the school and wait on the grass area outside the doors.
- Teachers will be contacting you via email or TEAMS to let you know which teacher and room number you will be assigned.
- After entering the building, you are required to use the hand sanitizer located on the table immediately beside the doors before going to your assigned classroom.

While at school:

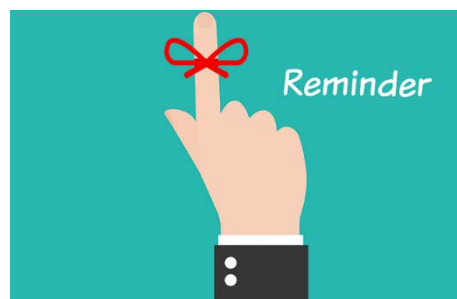
- Students are asked to remain in their designated rooms for the duration of their scheduled time.
- Students are only permitted to use the designated washrooms (one at a time) to ensure we are meeting regulations.
- Vending machines have been discontinued and will not be available. Students are permitted to bring water with them.
- Please bring any supplies/technology with you and remember to take all your belongings home with you at the end of your scheduled time.
- There will be no technology available to students at school during their scheduled time.

Leaving school:

- Students will be dismissed immediately after their scheduled time (or upon completion during their scheduled time).
- Students are not permitted to be on school property after their scheduled time.
- Please ensure students are picked up at the appropriate time
- Students are asked to eat their lunch at home or outside the school building.
- Students will exit the building using the same doors as they entered.
- Students will wash their hands using the hand sanitizer upon exiting the building.
