On Wednesday, Premier Horgan delivered the plan moving forward in opening the BC economy. He spoke about the possibility of schools reopening but he emphasised the need for student and staff safety first. We know this will be a gradual re-entry and the details continue to unfold. As always, we will move thoughtfully and purposefully to determine what will become the Salish Way.

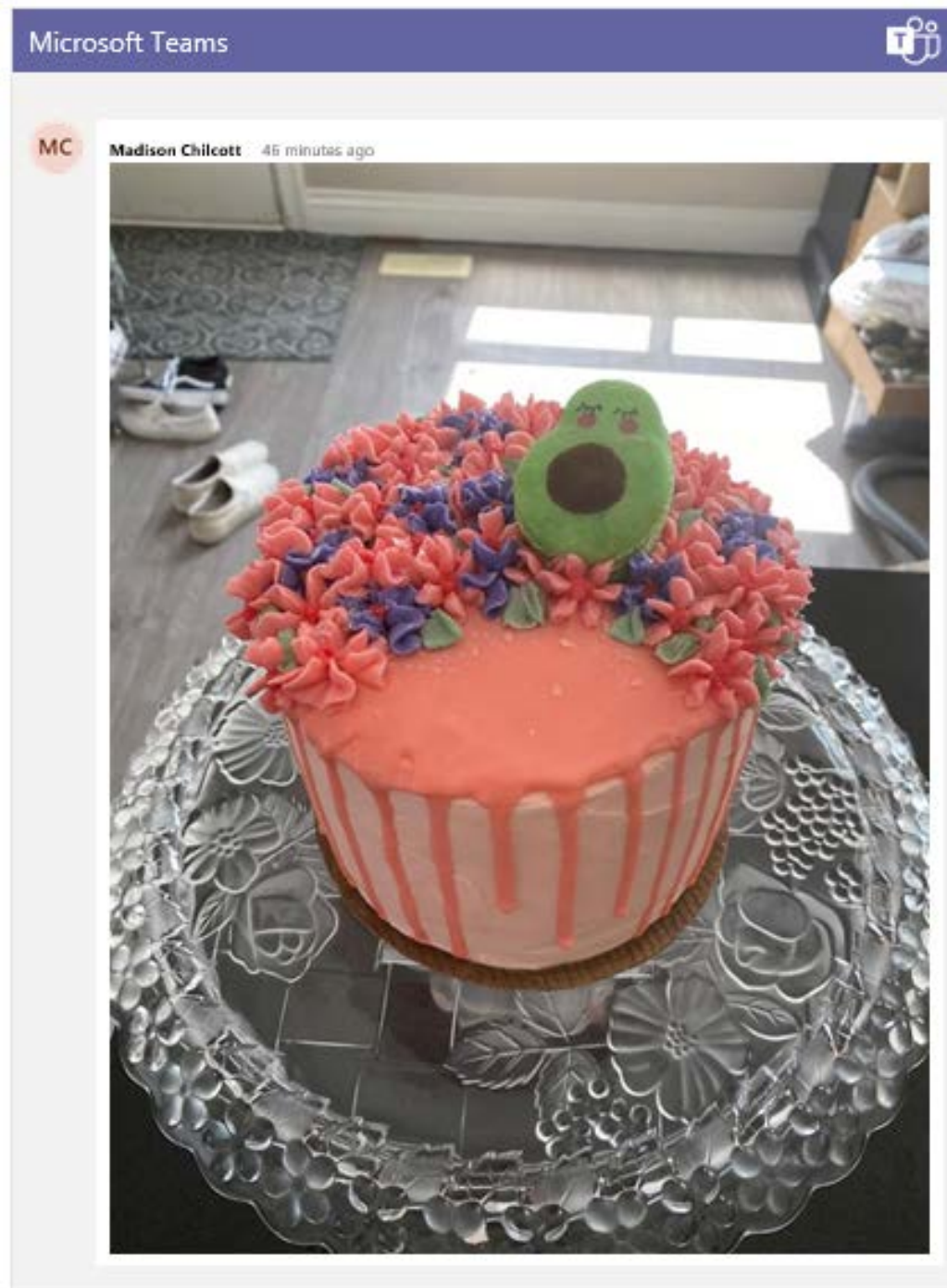
The weather is supposed to be gorgeous this Mother's Day weekend. We hope everyone is able to gather in small groups at home. Have a safe and Happy Mother's Day!
