Application for Gr. 8 Reps	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Need to make an application, voting process, and establish how to elect reps • Aiming for 5 representatives (one per SESM class) <p>How to introduce the idea:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Talk about it at the welcoming assembly for grade 8s for a heads up <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - showcase how to apply - what leadership traits we are looking for, who can qualify • Could maybe pitch during school tour • Pitch during club days <p>How the process may look next year:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold application process and election maybe after the grade 8 retreat or a month after school started • References may be difficult <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Therefore, no references needed • Maybe still have applications so they get familiar with things <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - have questions without teacher references - run by SESM teachers beforehand • Can put up posters and get Grade 8 teachers to spread the word • Maybe have one rep per SESM class <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - have them make a speech to present in front of their own class - have maybe 3 members to go talk to each SESM class • Each class could vote for one representative 	<p>Vote on application and election process on teams:</p> <p>Have interested people fill out an application. Will choose candidates based on the SESM teacher and have class vote on a candidate.</p> <p>or</p> <p>Have them do a speech in front of each class and have the class vote on the person.
