Choice Days

When it is raining students have the choice to stay inside their classrooms at recess and lunch or to go outside. If parents wish to have their child(ren) stay inside the school during a choice day then they should discuss their



expectation with their child(ren).

All students are expected to be dressed appropriately for all weather conditions.

For Ghosts and Goblins:

- Carry a flashlight and visit only houses that are well lit. Never go inside houses.
- Never eat any treats until your parents have checked them.
- Stay in your own neighbourhood and be sure to be back home at the time your parents tell you.
- Walk in groups and stay together. Visit houses on one side of the street at a time.



A reminder that School District Policy strictly prohibits students from bringing weapons or weapon replicas to school. This includes toy weapons that



are part of a costume.

Fireworks are banned and not permitted at school.

For Parents:

- Make sure that drivers can see your child. Use reflective tape on the front and back of the costume for better visibility.
- Use face make-up or paint for better vision. If a mask is used, cut large eye openings and encourage children to push their masks up on their heads while walking.
- To prevent falling, costumes should not be longer than your child's ankle.
- Instruct your child not to eat anything until you have checked it - a light meal before departure will help.
- Plan a route with your children and set a designated time to be home.
- Keep outside lights on and your yard clear of toys or obstacles.


