## Kindergarten Registration

Aussie "lingo" - some of the words we use like Registration for kindergarten begins January 13th at our school at 8:00a.m. Children who turn five years old before December 31, 2020 may start Kindergarten in September 2020.

> You must register your child for kindergarten in person and bring the 1 following documents:



- Proof of birth date for the student (birth certificate or passport);
- Proof of guardianship (parents/guardians shown on birth certificate or child tax credit);
- Proof of citizenship for both the parents and the students (birth certificate, citizenship passport, landed immigrant document, permanent resident card); and,
- Proof of residency (purchase or rental agreement, property tax document, Hydro or gas bill). Please note that these documents must be originals and dated within the last 2 months.

Immunization records and a B.C. Care Card are also helpful for the school to have on file.

# Registration For Programs Of Choice

If an older sibling of a child entering kindergarten in September 2020 is not already enrolled in a program of choice (e.g. Fine Arts, French Immersion) you can enter an online lottery for registration. For more information visit:
