COVID-19 Exposure Letters

regarding communicating a COVID-19 school district to distribute information to exposure. The letter is part of the district's effort to be transparent and to notify school communities of COVID-19 exposures as soon as public health notifies the district.

In some cases, a second *Self-Monitoring Letter* is distributed to specific individuals and family members informing them that they may have been exposed to COVID-19. Staff and students (via parents) receiving this letter are asked to closely monitor for COVID-19 symptoms.

All communication is distributed by the school district. Email addresses of parents are collected from the most recent email address the school has on record.

Construction Update

The Surrey School Board is planning a Digital Public Information Meeting on Wednesday, February 3rd from 5:30p.m. to 6:30p.m. Additional information on the meeting is included in this News Bulletin.

Basically, the proposed roof line of the addition will match the existing building, but does not meet the new height restrictions for construction. The maximum height of a building in this area was reduced sometime after the building was built.

If the DVP is not approved the plans for the addition will have to be redrawn, causing a delay in the construction of the addition.

NOTICE OF DIGITAL PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT a **DIGITAL** Public Information Meeting will be hosted by the **Board of Education School District No. 36 (Surrey)** on **Wednesday February 3, 2021,** from **5:30pm to 6:30pm**. The meeting will be run as a "Live Event" using Microsoft Teams. The purpose of the meeting is to introduce a proposed Development Variance Permit (DVP) application which, if approved, would permit a 1,046 square metre (11,255 square foot) addition to the east side of White Rock Elementary. The variance sought would enable the addition to have heights of 12.4 metres to the "top of ridge" and 15.7 metres to the "top of cupola", which would match the height of the existing ridge and cupola, whereas the existing Civic / Institutional Use (P-1) Zone establishes a maximum height of 10.7 metres; all other applicable standards of the P-1 Zone would be upheld in addition to the general standards of City of White Rock Zoning Bylaw, 2012, No. 2000 (e.g., parking).

The following Ortho Map identifies the subject property and illustrates the location of the existing school. The addition would be located east of the school, in an area currently comprised of open lawn / grass. The setback of the addition, from the eastern property line, would exceed the minimum 6 metre requirement.
