CHECK UP BACK UP WASH UP MASK UP

VAX UP

Check Up: Every day, check to see how you are feeling, and stay home if you aren't feeling well. If you have symptoms, get tested.

Back Up: Be mindful and considerate of others' personal space. Try to keep your hands to yourself and only play with your friends.

Wash Up: Wash or sanitize your hands regularly, including after playing outside, going to the bathroom, when putting on or removing your mask, and before and after eating. Be sure to wash your hands for at least 20 seconds.

Mask Up: All K-12 staff and Grade 4-12 students must wear a mask indoors. K-3 students are encouraged to wear a mask. Ensure your mask is clean and dry, is a good fit, and covers your nose and mouth fully. And remember, don't touch your face or play with your mask.

Vax Up: If you haven't already, <u>register to receive your first and second dose of the COVID-19</u> <u>vaccine</u>. Getting vaccinated is the most effective way to reduce infections and transmission of coronavirus.

SCHOOL SAFETY PROTOCOLS and PROCEDURES:

- Parents and caregivers are responsible to assess their child(ren) each day before going to school K-12 Health Check
- Parents/visitors will first be offered virtual meetings or phone calls.
- Parents/Visitors are to:
 - Make an appointment
 - Perform a health check prior to entering the building
 - Wear a mask
 - Sign-in with contact information at the office
 - Respect others' personal space
 - Only access areas required for the visit
- All students, staff and family members must stay home if they are sick and not enter the school.
- Minimizing physical contact both indoors and outside.
- Regular, scheduled hand washing and hand sanitizing.
- Students enter and exit school through exterior classroom doors.
- Reduced and directional hallway traffic keep right.
- Masks are mandatory for all staff and students in Grades 4-7. Masks are strongly encouraged for K-3 students.
- Students will follow good hygiene practices (wash hands frequently, cough into elbow, avoid physical contact, etc.).
- Increased outdoor learning and play (dress appropriately for our "Westcoast" weather).
- Limited shared materials.
- Excess furniture and resources removed from classrooms to create more space.
- Regular cleaning and disinfecting.
- No sharing of food including snacks, lunch, birthday treats.
- Ensure your child arrives at school on time each day, limit early pick up times.
- No items/lunch can be dropped off at the office during the school day.

ALLERGY AWARENESS

Several Erma Stephenson students have severe anaphylactic reactions to peanuts, nuts and their by-products. Please do not send foods to school that contain these products. Thank you for your continued understanding and cooperation as we endeavour to make our school a safe environment for all students.

** Please inform the school immediately if your child has a severe life-threatening allergy so we can ensure appropriate procedures are in place.
