Grade 7 students	Meet outside room #29
Grade 6 students	Meet in the front courtyard by the doors (see map)
Grade 5 students	Meet outside room #33
Grade 4 students	Meet in the front courtyard by the side walk (see map)
Grade 3 students	Meet outside room # 25
Grade 2 students	Meet outside the primary entry doors (see map)
Grade 1 students	Meet outside the primary entry doors (see map)

There will be bulletin boards outside to help assist families, along with teachers to direct students as needed. Children will be dismissed from these same locations at 11:00AM


What will the rest of the week look like?
