
Fraser Health updates

- Vaccination is the best way to protect our communities and ourselves. Clinic locations are available at <u>fraserhealth.ca/vax</u>
- All K to 12 staff, students in grades 4 to 12, and visitors wear masks in all indoor areas
- Students will continue to complete a daily health check, stay at home when feeling sick, and practice diligent hand hygiene. The daily health check is <u>here</u>.
- Strict physical distancing and cohorting is no longer required
- As per provincial direction, public health will notify staff and students who need to take specific action in the event of an exposure

Drop-off and Pick-up

When driving onto school property to drop-off or pick-up your child curbside, please remain in your vehicle. The front of the school is drop-off/pick-up only and not meant for parking. If you need more time to drop-off/pick-up your child, please park on one of the neighbouring streets and walk to the school. Also, please use the crosswalks on 142nd Street and in the school's parking lot. We ask drivers to obey all traffic signs including the NO LEFT TURN for traffic coming up 142nd and wanting to enter the school. Students should always exit and enter the vehicle on the sidewalk side not the lane side. Please refer to this map - thank you!

- 3. Click "Register" and follow the steps

 - in to your account and add each of your
 - children to your household account

Once you have registered your child, you will be able to see when they have a new item posted online for purchase. You will also have the option to be notified whenever your child has a new school expense due, so you don't have to worry about missing the deadline.
