
Kindergarten Registration Starts...

It's time to register for KINDERGARTEN. Those children who will turn 5 before January 1, 2023 are eligible to begin school in September 2022. Registration began on Monday, January 10th and can be done through the online school District website.

To register, take pictures (to attach) or scan and attach the citizenship for both the parent and your child, proof of residency, and proof of guardianship. For proof of residency, we require any three of the following: purchase or rental agreement, income tax statement, property tax statement, utility bill, drivers' licence, Care Card, BC identification or a signed letter form your landlord. These can also be scanned and attached (or take pictures to attach).

It is very important to register as quickly as possible as the District bases the teacher allocation on our enrollment. Thank you for your assistance in getting registrations in as soon as possible.

Mask and Safety Protocols...



Masks are mandatory for all Elementary school students and staff. We strongly encourage you to send your child with 3 ply masks as they provide better protection than cloth masks. Masks should fit properly for the child's face so that the nose and mouth are covered, and no open spaces are on the sides of the face. We encourage parents to keep your 6 feet social distancing while waiting for your child to enter or exit the building. We also encourage parents to wear a mask while on site as well.

Rapid Test Distribution...

The Government has issued five rapid tests to each child at our school. Tests must be picked up from our school by parents/guardians only. Please see the message sent directly to parents by Mr. Atwal about pick up dates, times, and procedures.
