## **Kindergarten registration**

Kindergarten registrations for September 2021 will begin *ONLINE* on January 11 at 8:00 am. Children who were born in **2016** are eligible to begin school in September 2021. The Surrey School District has a new online registration system for parents <u>here</u>.

Once your online registration form is processed, the school will contact you regarding required documentation.

- 1. Proof of birth date for the student (birth certificate or passport).
- 2. Proof of guardianship (parents/guardians as shown on birth certificate or other appropriate legal documentation)
- 3. Proof of citizenship for both parents (birth certificate, citizenship card, passport, landed immigrant document, permanent resident card)
- 4. Three pieces of identification showing the address of residence (purchase or rental agreement, utility bill, driver's license, etc.)
- 5. Immunization Record
- 6. Care Card #
