- <u>Daily Health Checks</u> should continue to be practiced by students, staff and parents. If you feel unwell, stay home.
- Masks are no longer required in indoor settings, though students and staff may continue to wear a mask as a personal choice. Disposable masks will continue to be available at the office for those that wish to use them.
- For those that have travelled outside of Canada, please follow the <u>federal travel guidance</u>, including wearing a mask when in public spaces, both indoors and outdoors for 14 days following entry into Canada.
- Hand hygiene measures will continue to be practiced while at school. Students will be reminded to wash their hands with soap and water, or use hand sanitizer, before/after eating and when reentering the building after outdoor breaks.
- Visitors are allowed at schools again. To support student and staff safety, all visitors to Hjorth Road Elementary must check in at the office upon entering the school.
- School Gatherings remain permitted at 50% capacity indoors until the PHO Gatherings and Events Order is lifted. Spectators may attend gatherings and events such as theatre productions, sports games and tournaments within capacity limits. Proof of vaccination is not required to attend school-led gatherings and events.
- Classroom arrangements may return to previous learning environment configurations that best meet student needs and preferred educational approaches. At Hjorth Road we will continue to consider strategies that create space between students in the classroom and school-at-large.
- Field trips are permitted. Venues that limit participation for all students due to additional requirements will be avoided.
