# Digital Citizenship at School – a reminder

The use of personal devices at school is a privilege given to our students with the understanding that the following expectations will be respected and upheld at all times.

- The use of electronic devices is not permitted during recess and lunch.
- Devices must remain in the student's backpack unless under direct supervision and with permission from the instructing teacher.

should students demonstrate difficulty following these expectations, electronic devices will be retained by the classroom teacher until the end of the school day. Subsequent concerns will require consultation with Mrs. Colter and the student's parents and may result in a loss of privileges.
