Year End Events:

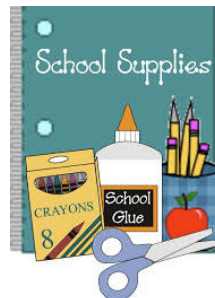

Used School Supplies:

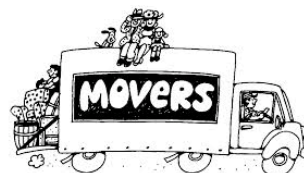
