Please let us know as soon as possible if your children will not be attending Ray Shepherd in the fall. This assists us a great deal in planning for September!



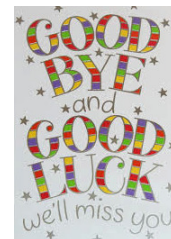
## Thank You Parents:
