WEST COAST WEATHER ... Recess and Lunch Play

In order to maximize learning focus in our classrooms and in keeping with COVID practice, Mary Jane Shannon follows a WEST COAST Recess/Lunch Play Practice. Unless our weather is extreme, students will be going outside to play on rainy days. Please ensure your child comes to school with appropriate rainwear including boots, a rain jacket and umbrella. Parents of primary children may wish to send an extra set of clothing (pants, socks) as those puddles can sometimes be very difficult to resist!

Extra Time Club - Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:30-3:30pm

We will be offering afterschool academic support with our amazing Child Care Workers (CCW) and dedicated teachers - formerly called the 'Homework Club', this is now the 'Extra Time Club'. This club will be run by teacher volunteers and the CCW's in the Library every Tuesday and Thursday from 2:30pm to 3:30pm starting Oct. 20th to Dec. 10th.

Teachers will recommend grade 4 to 7 students that may need extra time to complete an assignment, read quietly or seek some help with work. Students are expected to stay the full hour and have their work with them.

Classroom teachers will make sure parents/guardians are contacted before attending the Extra Time Club. Younger siblings may stay in the Library and can read quietly. **Student Drop-off:**

For the safety of all children, please note the following parking and drop-off restrictions:

- Staff Parking lot: No parking or drop off permitted.
- Student Drop off lane located on 106A Ave.: Drop off only; NO Parking is permitted.

Your cooperation with this drop off lane enables a very quick and safe area for children. When using our drop off lane, please practice the following safety guidelines

- Ensure your child gets out of the car on the curb side only
- Continue to move your car to the farthest point, allowing room for new cars to enter.
- Do not leave your car If you leave, you are considered parked and this is a traffic violation in this area.


