SCHOOL FEES

GREAT NEWS!

Student fees, Refundable Book Deposit and Grad Tickets will now be able to be paid online. You will need to register with SchoolCashOnline (instructions below) in order to do this. It is fast, safe and convenient. As well, when you create your profile, you can choose your language of choice in the lower lefthand corner of the screen.

North Surrey Learning Centre charges a \$15 Student Activity Fee and a \$25 refundable book deposit payable upon registration.

Student Activity Fee:

This fee covers the cost of go cards, year end, student activities and athletics, recognition and celebrations.

Refundable Book Deposit:

A \$25 deposit is collected from all students for the use of various textbooks and novels. This deposit is refunded, in its' entirety, to students who return all of their books upon withdrawal or graduation. If a student loses a book, the cost is deducted and a partial refund will be issued.


Why sign up for School Cash Online?

School Cash Online is an online parent portal that offers a safe, fast and convenient way to pay for school activity fees.

Credit Card

Pay with Visa or MasterCard on School Cash Online by entering your credit card number, CVV number (the three digits on the back of your card), card expiry date, and billing information.



eCheck

An electronic version of a paper check used to make payments online. Anyone with a checking or savings account can pay by eCheck on *School Cash Online*.



myWallet

An online wallet that can be loaded to hold funds and pay for your child's fees on *School Cash Online*. myWallet also allows you to allocate funds to pay for school fees at a later date.



Interac Online

Pay directly from your bank account with Interac Online.
