Louis Riel was a leader of the Métis people of the Canadian prairies, and in BC we commemorate Louis Riel Day on November 16. He helped lay the framework for minority rights and cultural co-operation, and is regarded as a founder of Manitoba. Think about recognizing Métis culture in the week preceding November 16<sup>th</sup>.

Next week is short but very busy. Wednesday is Grade 9 Take Our Kids to Work Day. Thursday afternoon will be our Remembrance Day assemblies. Friday is a Pro-D leading into a 4-day long weekend.
