After School Procedures:

Just a reminder, that students are expected to go straight home after school unless their parent/caregiver is outside supervising them. As well, please ensure your child knows "the plan" for what to do/where to go/who is picking them up after school (going with a friend, taking the bus, etc.) – a note in their agenda is helpful. Students should only be using the phone in the case of emergency. If there are unexpected changes to your child's afterschool pickup/bus arrangements, etc., please contact the office directly.

Our current COVID-19 practices make going outside especially critical this school year.


Please send your child dressed for the rainy, cold weather, boots, umbrellas, hats and raincoats are essential items.

Parking and Traffic Safety:


Please keep students and our community safe by:
