# SD 36 THANKS THESE GENEROUS DONORS...

## **CHARITY FOUNDATION OF CANADA**

\$10,000 in donations across 4 elementary school sites. Each school is able to use the funds for classroom technologies, field trip costs, art/sport supplies and other general school needs.

#### **COAST CAPITAL**

\$24,000 donation towards our REACH pre employment program that delivers employment training, training certifications, work experience and job seeking and preparation skills to at-risk youth in Surrey. Students gain certifications including Food Safe, First Aid and High 5 recreation instruction program while also developing skills that can transfer into immediate and future job or entrepreneurial opportunities.

\$5,000 donation towards our Building Foundations Program. This program focuses on responding to the unique needs of school aged youth with developmental disabilities and mental health issues by providing them with opportunities to obtain, maintain and excel in a job and build economic self-reliance.

Solomon Elimimian, the 2014 CFL Defensive Player of the Year, and All-Star receiver Emmanuel Arceneaux, visited Surrey Elementary schools and spoke about the importance of living a healthy lifestyle.

#### **DAYTRIPPER'S**

**\$2,000** provided for 2 schools to attend field trips to the Vancouver Aquarium, and the HR MacMillan Space Centre. The donation covers the cost of transportation and admission fees.

## **ELECTRONIC RECYCLING ASSOCIATION**

Triumph over Trauma allows students and families to share and address past traumas that they may struggle to express through language.

\$203,000 donation to the district's after school Jumpstart Academy physical literacy program. The donation allows students at 35 elementary school sites to participate in weekly after school sessions where students learn fundamental movement skills and the importance of healthy lifestyles.

\$42,500 towards our REACH and Bike Repair Program. Bike Repair is a pre-employment training program that delivers hands-on training and practical work experience in bike technician repair, bike retail sales, and cycling safety to vulnerable youth.
