Principal's Message

What a fantastic first semester of the 2018-19 school year. Although final exams for first semester are right around the corner, it is still not too late to take advantage of the time left. December is a quick month. Students are in positive spirits as there are only 3 weeks left before the Christmas break. The holiday season is here and winter break is on the horizon.

The first formal report card for this year was available on Nov 28th. If you need to ask our teachers some questions about your child's learning, they are always willing to hear your questions or concerns. Please call our school or email the teachers you need to hear from. I am pleased that 464 students achieved honour roll standing. Among these honour roll students, 81 had a 4.0 GPA. Congratulations to our hard working T-Wolves! A list of these students is provided in this newsletter; please note that because the Grade 8's are in full year classes, they cannot be accurately added to the honour roll for this reporting period. Grade 8 Honour Roll will be available with the February report cards.

Our athletic department has been very busy with our students participating in soccer, volleyball, and cross country. Our teams have done very well. The senior girls' volleyball team entered the Tier II BC Championships- we were very optimistic about their chances and they did a fantastic job finishing 13th. Congratulations to all the coaches and players on a successful fall season. We are very fortunate to have many dedicated teachers, parents and community members who devote time and energy to providing these opportunities for our students. I know both students and parents appreciate their efforts. Our winter sports season has started and we are running basketball teams at all levels. When the Christmas break is over, there will be only four school weeks left in this semester. This means that the final class projects, government exams, and course competency assignments are fast approaching. Please emphasize with your child that for success in all semester end assignments, review is important. Establishing a study schedule in preparation for the completion of courses and exams can reduce anxiety and increase success in all academic classes.

There has been a slight change to our first semester end schedule from the original posting. I want our parents to be aware that the last day of regular scheduled classes for semester 1 is Wednesday January 23rd. The two following days, January 24th and 25, are days for students to show competency within a course. Teachers will be in their classrooms as per the block schedule. Students can use these days to meet with their teacher to complete learning outcomes they have missed or did not perform well in. The start of Semester 2 is on Monday January 28st.

Our Final Parent Advisory Council meeting for the calendar year of 2018 will place on Wednesday December 5th from 7:00-9:00 pm. The event will be in the library classroom. All parents and guardians are welcome to attend.

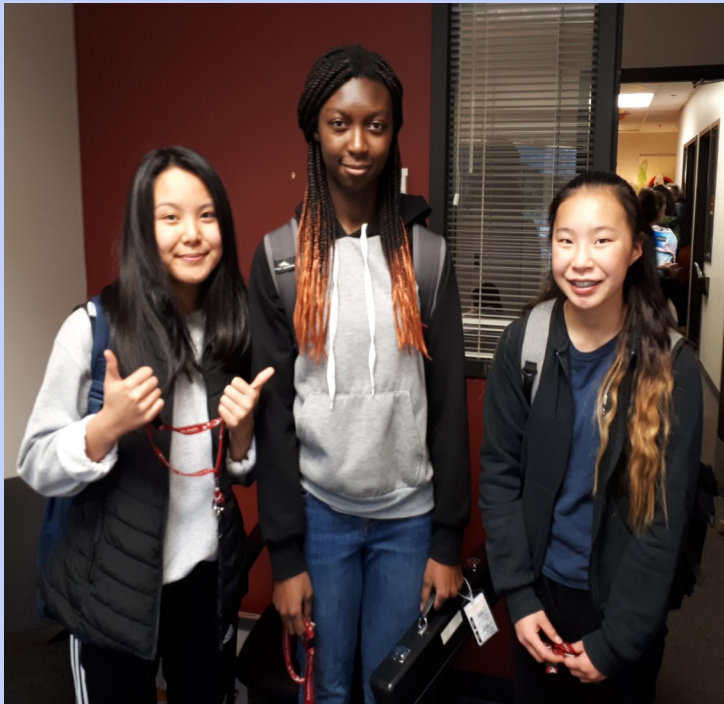

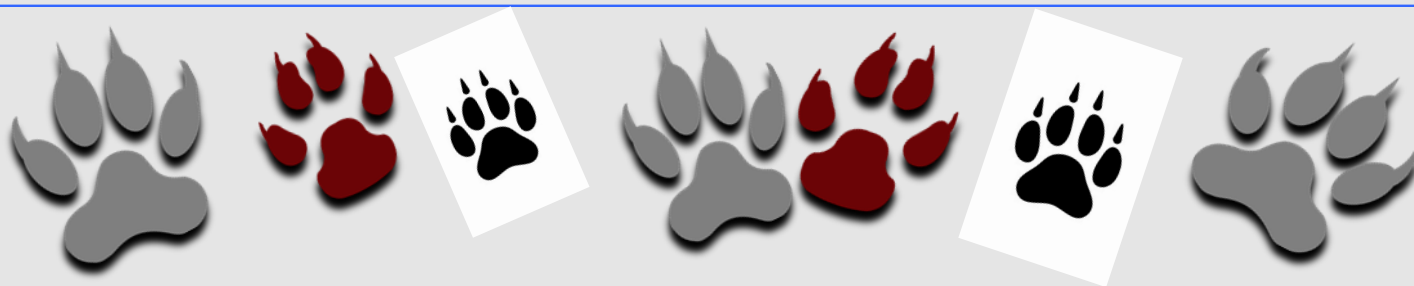

The Santa's Workshop Winter Pep Rally will take place during Block A on Wednesday, December 20th.

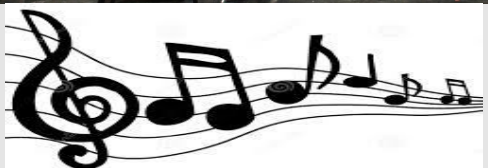
The 6th Annual Senior Boys Basketball Winter Tip Off tournament will take place on Thursday, December 20th and Friday, December 21st!

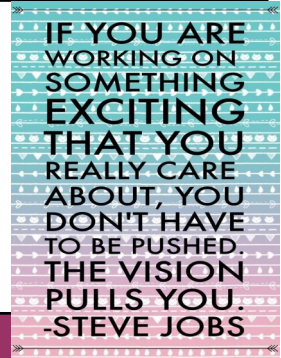

Early January: Successful Interview

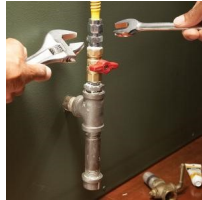
