# Parking at the School



As many of you drive your children to and from school, you can appreciate the congestion that occurs in our parking lot, particularly before and after school. We commit to you that we will do our best to get your children in the door safely, but we will need your help.


Do not park in the DROP OFF ZONE, but do find a parking spot.

- Do not leave your car unattended in the DROP OFF Zone
- Once you have parked in a designated parking spot, you are then able to accompany your students safely to the door, or remind them to watch for moving traffic.
- Do not park along the brick wall outside the gymnasium at the end of the day. Many staff are leaving the building at that time as well, and are finding that parked cars are blocking them in. Please find a parking spot in the lot or on the street.
- Do not sit in your car at pick up with the engine idling. It is particularly difficult for our Kindergarten children whose doors and windows open to that area.

If you choose to enter the parking lot, please follow the protocol established for our drop off lane. That is, drivers are to stay in their car and continue to move toward the exit. Parking your car in this lane stops the flow of traffic and results in frustration and unsafe conditions for your children. If you have intermediate children, it is strongly suggested that you identify a pick up spot away from the parking lot area. Whenever possible, we encourage you to walk to school with your children.

## Lice Checks

Head lice are a reality in school populations and though they are not a health hazard, the are a real nuisance to families. Anyone can have head lice and it doesn't mean a person is unclean. "Head lice can be best controlled through the cooperation of parents, children and the school.". You can help by checking your child's scalp and hairline on a regular basis. We ask that parents report when their child has head lice so that we can alert other families in the classroom to check their child at home.



#### Nit Wit Team
