



#### **Growth Mindset**

The staff at EKOLogy are working at developing our students' growth mindset. We want students to learn enjoy tackling challenges and to understand that learning takes a lot of effort. Students are learning that they don't give up when things get difficult because they have strategies to persevere. They take risks and understand that mistakes are normal when people try hard things.

Parents can foster a growth mindset at home as well. You can start with how you praise children. Praising your child's efforts, rather than their products or their intelligence, develops the idea that effort leads to success in learning.

#### Try reframing praise using the following ideas:
