<u>Parking</u>

I have received MANY calls throughout October complaining about the parking at the school. Without a doubt, like many schools, parking is limited therefore, it is critical that everyone do their part to help out. Please consider the following:

If you are within walking distance of the school, enjoy the fresh air and health aspect of walking to school.

The drive through area is meant to speed up pick-up and drop offs. Please do not park your car and leave it unattended as this creates a traffic jam.

All areas marked in yellow are FIRE LANES and cars must not stop at all in these areas (this is a city bylaw). Consider picking up your child 10 minutes after the bell as supervisors are on duty until 2:45 pm. This will spread the traffic flow out.

IMPORTANT

Please walk to either end of the drop off area rather than cutting in between the cars. We know it is an extra few meters however, students and parents cannot always be seen by drivers when crossing mid-point.

Please note – cars were ticketed on Friday by the City of Surrey. This is always an unpleasant situation so please remember that you must stay in your car and have your son/daughter come to your car.
