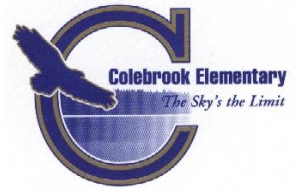


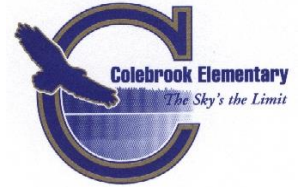
## Colebrook PAC General Meeting Minutes

**Christmas Tree** – we are seeking one, as the one we had in previous years is broken

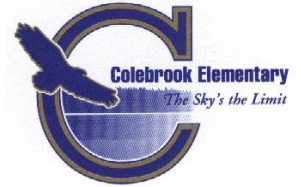
### **School Wishlist:**
