Allergy-Aware School

Several of our students at North Ridge have severe life-threatening allergies/allergic reactions to peanuts, nuts and their by-products, as well as other food products. Please help us in doing everything possible to protect these students. Some ways you can help include: refraining from sending food to school that contain peanuts/nuts, remind your child to wash their hands carefully after eating if there is an anaphylactic student in your child's classroom, remind your child to not share or trade snacks and do not use these products in any treats that you may send into the classroom throughout the year. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we continue to make our school a safe environment for all of our students.

Please inform the school immediately if your child has a severe life-threatening allergy or medical condition so we can ensure appropriate procedures are in place



Halloween at North Ridge

We will be having our Halloween Integrated Day on Tuesday, October 31st. The teachers have planned a great day for the students with fun activities, a costume parade, as well as a Halloween Assembly. Students are invited to wear their costumes to school on Halloween. A reminder from our Safe Schools Department regarding Halloween costumes: "It is expected that students will not use, possess or display any weapon, replica weapon or toy weapon, on any school property or at any event that is organized or sponsored by a school." Please remind your children that replica or toy weapons are not allowed at school even if they are part of their Halloween costume.

Halloween in the Community

We are asking that all students be aware and practice all safety rules on Halloween. These safety rules will be discussed with students both in class as well as during our Halloween assembly. Every Halloween children and adults are seriously injured and sometimes killed by fireworks. According to Surrey and White Rock bylaws, it is illegal for any person to be in the possession of fireworks of any kind. The only exception is for persons who have a valid federal supervisor's certificate from the Explosives Regulatory Division of Natural Resources Canada. However, city permits must be obtained and other restrictions still apply. The penalty for violating the bylaw is a fine of up to \$5,000 and seizure of the fireworks. Any fireworks brought on school property will be confiscated and students involved face suspension. Please report any suspicious activity around the school grounds after school hours and especially throughout the week up to and including Halloween. We will have Security on site at North Ridge during Halloween so that our school is monitored that night.

Parking Reminders

Please help us keep our student's safe. **Our Parking lot is for Staff only**. We ask that families not use the lot as the spots are for Staff, as we often have Staff coming and going throughout the day. Students are not to be in the parking lot during the day. Students and families are asked to access the school using the stairs or the ramp. Please do not walk up the parking lot entrance. As many of you may remember, we had the City of Surrey come out last year to do a review of the parking around our school. They have made some changes to parking around the schools. The area on 134th Street in front of the school is now designated as a 15-minute parking zone before and after school. The area in front of the school along 62nd Avenue is for drop off and pick-up only. There is no parking along this area and vehicles should keep moving to help with the congestion in the neighbourhood. Please note that we also have students who arrive to North Ridge by school bus. Our bus must pull up along the curb, please keep the traffic moving along 62nd Avenue to allow our students to exit or enter the bus. We encourage our students and families to walk or bike to school. We thank you for your support in this matter to ensure the safety of our students and families. Please see the attached map from the city of Surrey with designated parking and drop-off/pick-up areas.
