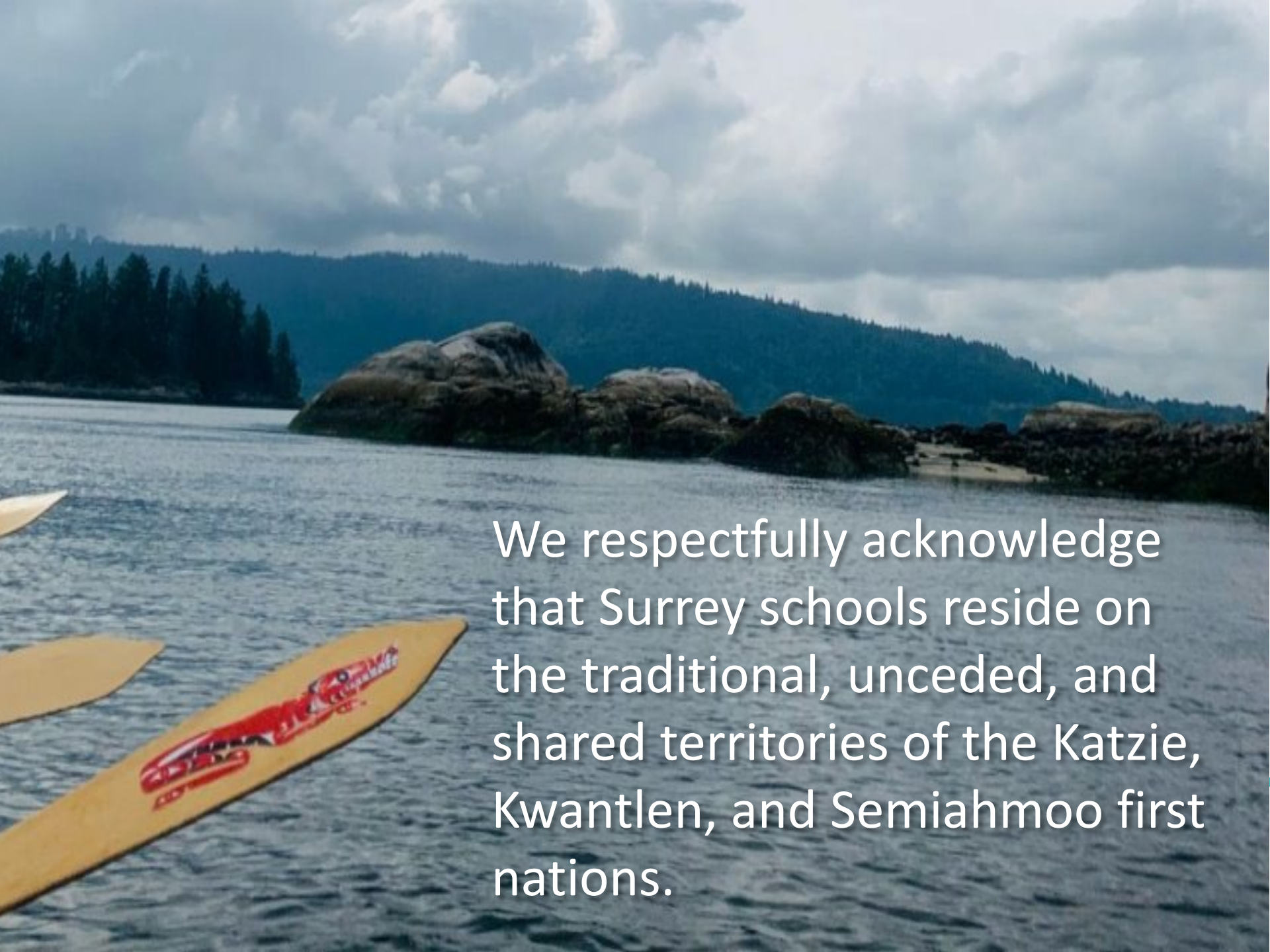

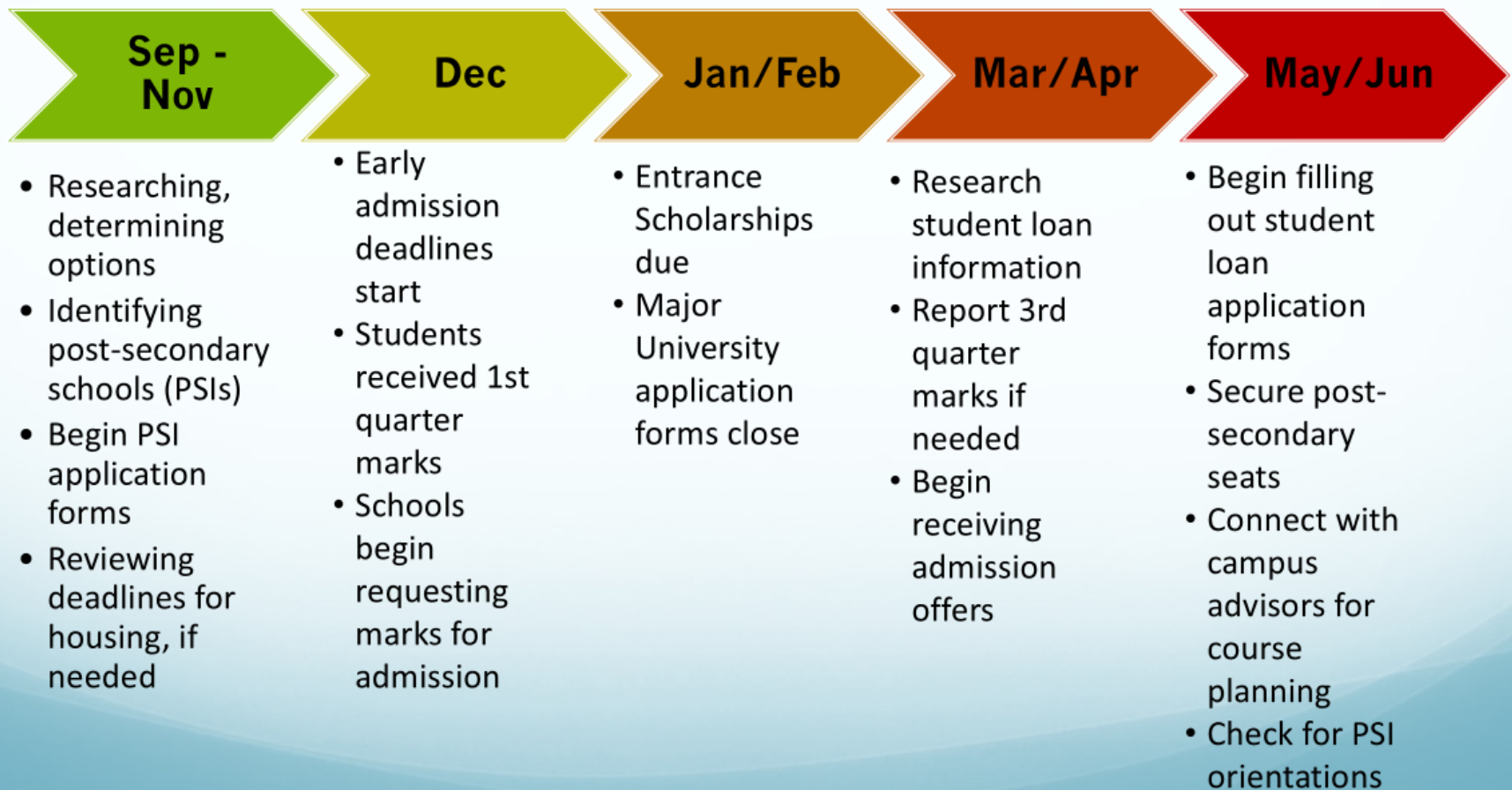
Graduation Requirements:

- Create a Student Transcripts Service (STS) account early in Grade 12.
- Select the post-secondary schools they're applying to (transcripts are sent automatically).
- Check graduation status and marks after final exams.

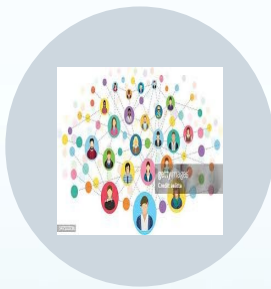

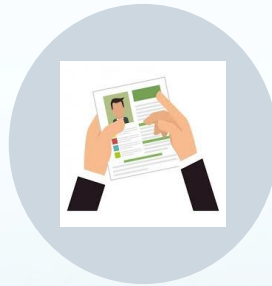

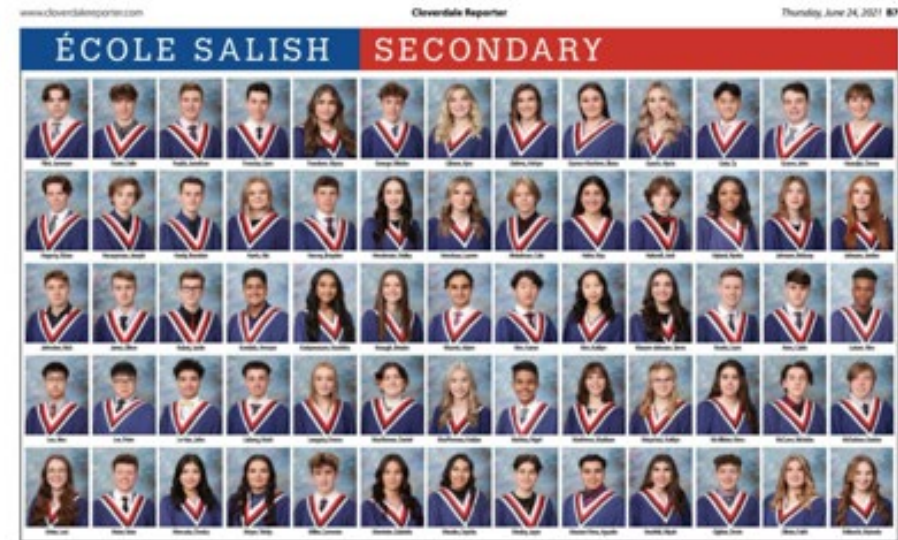
