We have already paid for plans that were drawn up by a professional landscape architect last year; the plan expands our front garden and forest grove into three distinct learning classrooms. This will require considerable funds working alongside the district. Our first priority is to create a more sustainable learning area in *Salh Tumuxw* (Our Learning Circle in the Forest Grove by the gardens). This is estimated to cost \$4000.

We are also writing grants to help expand our gardens with more beds, storage and gardening tools.
