PARKING WARNING

We currently have parents parking in no parking zones. Please observe all street parking signs and/or orange cones. Parking is only permitted in designated parking stalls. Do not park along the side of the parking lot entrance or block the fire lane entrance.

City bylaw officers and the RCMP do issue tickets to cars parked illegally. Please be sure to observe no parking areas.

School & Parking Safety Reminders

Your children are precious to you just as other children are precious to their parents.

Let's all keep this in mind when picking up and dropping off children for school.

Tips for drivers:

SLOW DOWN! A 30 km/h speed limit is in effect from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. in school zones.

PLEASE FOLLOW POSTED STREET SIGNS.

DO NOT PARK ON THE FIRELANE & NO STOPPING ZONES.

- **ENSURE YOUR CHILD EXITS THE VEHICLE SAFELY.** Children who are driven to school should exit the vehicle on the side closest to the curb or sidewalk.
- **DO NOT PASS.** Use caution when a vehicle in front of you stops as the driver may be yielding to a pedestrian crossing the street.
- ALWAYS YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS. Most of the pedestrians are children who are not always paying attention and are easily distracted.

Tips for students:

WALK ON SIDEWALKS. Walk, don't run across the street and always use sidewalks where available.

- **DON'T JAYWALK.** Drivers don't expect to see pedestrians away from intersections and crosswalks, so pedestrians are even less likely to be seen.
- **DO NOT CUT THROUGH THE PARKING LOT.** This is not a safe area for students to be walking. There is a lot of traffic coming through the parking lot and drivers are not always able to see children walking and zipping between parked and/or moving cars.
- **DON'T BE IN A RUSH TO CROSS THE STREET.** Before crossing the street, wait at the curb and make sure all vehicles have stopped. Look left and right, then over your shoulder for vehicles that may be turning.
- MAKE EYE CONTACT WITH DRIVERS BEFORE CROSSING AT A CROSSWALK. It's the best way to ensure they see you.
- AVOID DISTRACTIONS. Don't wear headphones, talk on the phone, text or use handheld devices when crossing a street.
