1. Nominees for the positions will be presented and voted on the following order:
2. President
3. Vice-President
4. Treasurer
5. Secretary
6. DPAC Rep
7. The president opens nominations by reading the names of any nominations that were submitted prior by email or in person.
8. There will be a call for nominees from the floor. A person can nominate someone or a person can nominate himself or herself. A nomination does not need a second. If nominating a person, please be sure they are willing to stand. A person can decline a nomination.
9. A person can be nominated for more than one position but can only hold one position.
10. There will be three calls for nominations from the floor.
11. After the third and final call the names of the nominees will be repeated to the members.
12. If there is only one nominee for the position, that person will assume the role by acclimation.
13. If there is more than one nominee for a position, voting will take place by secret ballot. The winner will be announced without revealing the numbers of votes cast for each nominee.
14. The process will be repeated for each position.
15. Positions that are not filled will remain vacant until a nominee is presented at a later date.
