**Review Proposed 2026 - 2027 Budget**

Reviewed the proposed budget for next school year.  
The freezie sales are higher this year.  
Projected income from all sources is \$44,900.  
The Gaming Grant of \$11,000 is on its way.

The Morgan PAC Scholarship at Grandview High School is up to \$2,000 to have two former students to receive \$1,000 each, instead of just one.  
Projected surplus at the end of the next school year estimated to be of \$4,790.

No changes were made or suggested.
