- Principal's Report Ms. Colgate
 - Ms. Colgate announced her transfer to another elementary school in September.
 - Expresses gratitude for school community these past 4 years
 - The school calendar for 2021/2022 school year will be released shortly
 - By May 30th, school will advise of school calendar and fees (school supplies)
 - Ms. Colgate will be sending a survey link for parents to complete if they wish to share any information that would affect classroom placements. Parents can also speak with their children's teachers
 - Ms. Colgate thanks PAC for all of the support given this school year.
- Vice Principal's Report Ms. Watson
 - Outdoor equipment arrived today and will be distributed to classrooms.
 - Admin was not able to book the presentation with Saleema Noon for this school year but will be considered for next year's health curriculum
- Mrs. Waraich Primary Teacher
 - Ms. Waraich put in a request in September for a home reading program and primary reading materials were purchased for this purpose, earlier this year with funds from PAC and the school.
 - The home reading program is on hold due to covid protocols and the books remain unused.
 - Admin would like to propose use of the new home reading program books for use in classrooms.
 - Early learning teachers don't have the best reading materials for in classroom learning
 - Admin proposes using the newer home reading program books for use in classrooms and using the older classroom books for the home reading program
 - Discussion surrounding current protocol for in classroom reading
 - Classroom books are not placed in a quarantine hold like the library, because the students in a classroom are in the same cohort.
 - Students place books in their plastic reading bag for the week
 - Discussion surrounding gaming protocols for using the books in classrooms
 - Tabled discussion for September
 - Mrs. Waraich requests use of the books in classrooms from now until the end of the school year, and the books will be placed back in the box for September.
 - Approved by acclamation for temporary use in classrooms
