## TREASURER REPORT

The PAC has 3 sources of Revenues that we are responsible for:

- 1. Community Gaming Funds: Funded each year based on the head count; generally around \$20/head. Current gaming balance: \$47,107 (includes \$32,040 from 2020-21)
- 2. PAC (in trust at District): Legacy funds held at the district we draw down on these funds as required for special requests, once these funds are gone, the account will close. Current Balance: \$4450
- 3. Sullivan PAC: Funded generally from parent contributions we send out a request for a \$20 donation from parents to add to the pool of resources. Current balance: \$2367.27

To date, there have been over 30 requests totalling \$46,750 from the teachers that fit into the gaming grant guidelines, as well as \$5167 in other requests. A committee was formed to make decisions on how to disburse future funds - the following parents put their name forward last month and will be contacted by the executive: Shareen / Jill / Harneet / Jaime / Amy / Stacey if there is anyone else interested, please let us know, thank you for volunteering! The PAC donation request will also be resent to the parents.
