Principal's Report:

- School Instructional Focus Update: The \$25,000 grant Beaver Creek received last year has primarily been spent on school technology. We're surveying fifty students randomly to measure whether or not student engagement has increased since our purchases have been being used. We're looking for evidence to figure out whether or not student learning has increased in a meaningful way. Interviews will take place in April and we should have our results sometime in May.
- **New School Focus:** Though it has not yet been voted on, we suspect our new school focus will be reading comprehension, more specifically, we want to focus on giving students a better sense of what critical thinking skills are, and why they're so important
- Funding Requests: 1. Whereas PAC had agreed to spend up to \$3000 for our new technology cart, the total cost ended up being \$2287.47. 2. Ipad Apps: A motion was made by Ms. Lewis to pay for the necessary apps for primary and intermediate students. The total cost amounts to \$2398.60. Seconded by Mrs. Kaur. 3. Cart speakers and adaptors: A motion was made by Ms. Lewis to pay for necessary cart speakers and adaptors, whose total cost came to \$786.68. Seconded by Mrs. Sahebzedah. 4. Updated Earthquake Bins: A motion was made by Ms. Lewis to spend up to \$1000 to update

- our expired earthquake bins. Seconded by Mrs. Kaur. **5. Classroom Fieldtrips:** A motion was made by Ms. Lewis to provide \$2000 for classroom fieldtrips, equal to \$100 per division. Seconded by Mrs. Sahebzedah. All motions were carried unanimously.
- **The Lion King:** Our spring musical will take place on April 28th, 30th. Ticket sales will be pre-sold. There will be at-the-door tickets ONLY if the pre-sold tickets have not sold out. Afternoon shows will be \$5 per seat. Evening shows will be \$7 per seat. As usual, there will be an accompanying t-shirt sale.
