Agenda Items

1. Teacher's wishlist
 - a. The PAC is covering all items:
 - Field trips? **We can use \$5500 (or more) towards new technology (from gaming account)**
 - Zumba **\$2700 this will be paid by our school-based performances account**
 - Class Incentives 24 FTE x \$150 = **\$3600 ****
 - Fraser Heights Scholarship **\$500 ****
 - Grade 7 Ceremony **\$1000 ****
 - Sports Day Ribbons **\$250 ****
 - Library Books **\$1000 still requesting this**
 - Grade 7 First Aid **\$1200 ****
 - Grade 7 Medals **\$850 ****
 - Fine Arts Performances – not happening this year
 - Other Misc. **\$1000 won't need this**
 - Items in Red confirmed by Heather.**
 - **(\$5,175 currently in PAC General/PAC classroom discretionary & \$2,115 currently in PAC field trip funds = \$7,290)**
 - PAC to issue a cheque for \$1,110 to fund the Library Books & balance outstanding from requested items (\$7,400 - \$7,290 = \$110 + \$1,000 for Library Books)**
2. Donation Drive
 - a. The School District has advised that they will let us know how much was raised by the middle of the month; sometime this week.
3. Book Fair
 - a. The Fall Book Fair has been put on hold as of now as parents are not allowed to attend.
 - b. Hopefully by spring, visitor restrictions will be relaxed and we will be allowed to invite parents to attend.
 - c. We are aiming to have it as a weeklong event, the week leading up to Spring Break.
4. HT Photography Family Photo Fundraiser
 - a. Monday November 15th – 18 families booked
 - b. Thursday November 18th – 11 families booked
 - i. HT Photography confirmed that even though we don't have 15 families booked (their minimum amount of bookings per night required), they will go ahead with the session; they will not cancel this event.

5. Munchalunch.com - \$268.80 was paid to reactivate the account for the school year.
 - a. Sushi hot lunch is confirmed for this Friday November 19th
 - b. Friday December 3rd will be a hot lunch day – TBD (will likely be Pizza)
 - c. The restaurant options that we are exploring are individually wrapping student orders per division and delivering right to the school.
 - d. In the New Year we will explore increasing our hot lunches from 1x per month to 2x per month.
6. LEGO kids raffle baskets
 - a. The PAC will purchase the LEGO sets and display them in the office window in December.
 - b. A newsletter regarding this fundraising event will be emailed via the school
